The City Council of the City of Lavaca met for a regular monthly meeting Monday August 14, 2017, at City Hall in Lavaca. Board members present were Mayor Hugh Hardgrave; Aldermen: Mike Ray, Rick Edgerton, Jeff Price, Dale Teague, Randy Overbey, Benny Hunter, attorney John Verkamp, and Recorder Shelly Hockaday. Visitors present were Steve Helms, Phil Beshoner, Randy Toon and Mac Green, .

The meeting was called to order at 7 P. M. Steve Helms led the Pledge of Allegiance and Hugh Hardgrave led the prayer.

Mayor Hardgrave spoke highly of Addie Heard and her service to the City of Lavaca over the years. She will be missed.

The Council approved the minutes of the July regular and special meeting as printed. (RE/MR)

Council members reviewed the report from the Police Dept. The Department answered 428 calls in July. Additionally, 42 traffic stops resulted in 9 traffic tickets, 6 criminal ticket and 33 warnings. There were 3 arrests made in the month of July.

Council members reviewed the report from the Fire Dept. The Department responded to 13 first responder calls, 1 fire call, 2 assist for roadway flooding. The fire dept also assisted the City with painting the crosswalks.

Council members voted all in favor of adopting resolution 2017-06 amending the original wording in the Police department financing project with First National Bank to include the interest payments until construction is complete. (BH/ RO)

The Council voted to pay the bills for the month of August. (DT/ RE)
