The meeting was called to order at 7 P. M. Mayor Hugh Hardgrave led the Pledge of Allegiance and Steve Helms led the prayer.

The Council approved the minutes of the June regular meeting as printed. BH/RE)

Council members reviewed the report from the Police Dept. The Department answered 403 calls in June. Additionally, 20 traffic stops resulted in 3 traffic tickets, 10 criminal ticket and 17 warnings. There were 10 arrests made in the month of June.

Council members reviewed the report from the Fire Dept. The Department responded to 13 first responder calls, 3 fire call, and 1 false alarm.

Council members voted all in favor of adopting resolution 2017-04 to utilize state aid street monies for the widening of Dogwood Street from S. Division to S. Davis Street if the project is approved and funded by the Committee. (RE/DT)

Council members voted all in favor of adopting resolution 2017-05 to seek grant funding from Arkansas Department of Parks and Tourism's Outdoor Recreation Grand Program. (MR/RO)

The Council voted to pay the bills for the month of July. (DT/RE)
