The City Council of the City of Lavaca met for a regular monthly meeting Monday June 10, 2019, at City Hall in Lavaca. Board members present were Mayor Hugh Hardgrave; Aldermen: Mike Ray, Gerald Schaefer, Rick Edgerton, Dale Teague, Lorie Robertson, and Benny Hunter; Attorney John Verkamp and Recorder Shelly Hockaday. Visitors present were Butch Maness, Steve Helms, Ken VanDusen, and Randy Toon.

The meeting was called to order at 7 P. M. Steve Helms led the Pledge of Allegiance and Mayor Hugh Hardgrave led the prayer.

The Council approved the minutes of the May regular meeting as printed. (DT/GS)

Council members reviewed the report from the Police Dept. The Department answered 370 calls in May and made 3 arrests. Additionally, 4 tickets and 8 warnings were issued.

Council members reviewed a request from Waste Management to increase rates from \$10.19 to \$10.51. Members voted to not accept the increase at this time. (RE/LR)

Council members voted to accept the high bid of \$1754.00 from Albert White for the F700 dump bed truck from sealed bids. (LR/MR)

Council members voted to accept the high bid of \$2250.00 from Mac Green for the F150 Ford Pickup from sealed bids. (BH/RE)

Council members voted to use the proceeds from the sale of the F150 Ford Pickup and the Dump Truck above to purchase a new dump trailer. (DT/LR)

Council members voted to introduce a new door to door sales ordinance. (DT/MR)

Council members voted to suspend the rules for the door to door sales ordinance and only read once. (RE/DT)

Council members voted to adopt the new door to door sales ordinance. (DT/GS)

Council members voted to reschedule the July study session to July 11, 2019 and the July Council meeting to July 15, 2019 due to the Holiday. (DT/RE)

The Council voted to pay the bills for the month of June. (RE/LR)

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
