The City Council of the City of Lavaca met for a regular monthly meeting Monday March 14, 2022, at City Hall in Lavaca. Board members present were Mayor Hugh Hardgrave, Aldermen: Gerald Schaeffer, Rick Edgerton, Dale Teague, Lorie Robertson, Benny Hunter, City Attorney John Verkamp and Recorder Shelly Hockaday. Aldermen Mike Ray was absent. Visitors present were Dwayne Wallace, Randy Toon, Steve Hotz, and Mark Allen.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P. M. Rick Edgerton led the Pledge of Allegiance and Mayor Hardgrave led the prayer.

The Council reviewed the minutes of the February regular meeting. Gerald Schaefer made a motion to approve the minutes as printed. Rick Edgerton seconded the motion and all voted in favor except Dale Teague, who abstained. Motion passed.

Council members reviewed the report from the Police Dept. The Department answered 359 calls in February. LPD issued 16 tickets and 27 warnings. There were 0 arrests made in the month of February.

Council members reviewed the report from the Fire Dept. They responded to 3 vehicle accidents, 1 fire alarm, and 16 EMS calls in February.

Council members reviewed a proposal from Hawkins-Weir Engineers, INC. for clearing and bank stabilization for the creek crossing at El Paso Street, North Davis Street, and along the sewer easement where the creek flows in the area of Oak Bower Park and down to Monte Lane. Dale Teague made a motion to proceed with the project. Rick Edgerton seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion passed.

Council members reviewed a proposed resolution honoring the Lavaca high school senior boys basketball team for winning the 2022 class 2A State Championship. Gerald Schaefer made a motion to adopt the resolution. Benny Hunter seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Resolution was adopted.

Rick Edgerton made a motion to pay the bills for the month of March. Gerald Schaefer seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion passed.
