The City Council of the City of Lavaca met for a regular monthly meeting Monday April 13, 2026, at City Hall in Lavaca. Board members present were Mayor Hugh Hardgrave, Aldermen: Mike Ray, Gerald Schaefer, Mac Green, Lisa Hogan, Lorie Robertson, Dawn Hutchins, City Attorney John Verkamp, and Recorder Shelly Vann. Visitors present were Jeremy Smith, Kynlee Schaefer, and Kirk Barber. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P. M. Lisa Hogan led the Pledge of Allegiance and Mac Green led the prayer.

The Council reviewed the minutes of the March regular meeting. Lisa Hogan made a motion to approve the meeting minutes as printed. Gerald Schaefer seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion passed.

Council members reviewed the report from the Police Dept. The Department performed 484 activities in March. LPD issued 17 tickets and 11 warnings. There were 5 arrests made in the month of March. Council members reviewed the report from the Fire Dept. They responded to: 3 fire calls, 24 EMS calls and 2 public safety events in March.

Council members reviewed the report from the Public Works Dept. They replaced 48 meters that were not working. Repaired 5 water leaks, and tested 10 generators. They also completed 23 one call requests.

Agenda Item 1: Ordinance, rezoning request 1400 block of West Main St. (2026-02) The request is to change zoning of the above property from C-1 to R-1. A motion to introduce by title only was made by Gerald Schaefer. Motion was seconded by Lorie Robertson and all voted in favor. Motion Passed. A Motion was made by Mike Ray to suspend the rules for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> readings. Lorie Robertson seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion Passed.

A motion was made by Lorie Robertson to adopt proposed ordinance 2026-02 and rezone from C-1 to R-1. Mike Ray seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion Passed and ordinance 2026-02 was adopted.

Lisa Hogan made a motion to pay the bills for the month of April. Gerald Schaefer seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion passed.

Gerald Schaefer made a motion to adjourn. Dawn Hutchins seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Meeting was adjourned.
